Description of the event:

The Greek Multiplier Event for WINGS Project took place on the 26th of October in Athens. The event was hosted in the Greek Forum of Migrants and took place between 17:30 - 19:30.

During the preparation of our Multiplier event we decided to co-organize the event with the Greek Forum of Migrants in order to achieve a more meaningful impact through gathering people from our target group, migrant women. Both organizations disseminated the invitation via social media posts and we spread the information to our networks through direct messages and emails.

As a result, the target audience of our multiplier event were 21 people, most of them women of migration background. Most of them have been living in Greece for more that ten years and we also had the chance to discuss with them upon their needs and challenges to integrate into the greek society.

The multiplier event followed the planned agenda. At the beginning, introductions among participants were made and then an introduction to the WINGS project, which covered the project aim, objectives, target groups, activities and results. Furthermore, we focused our attention to the concept of economic and social empowerment, we presented the results of our training programme and we got deeper through discussions and experience sharing. At this point we also watched some interviews from other women during their participation in our training programme. After having our coffee-break, we presented the WINGS website and the educational platform. We navigated through the courses and the material of the platform and







explained how it can be used. In addition, we tested the learning platform with the participants and received fruitful feedback from them with reflection, questions, comments and recommendations.

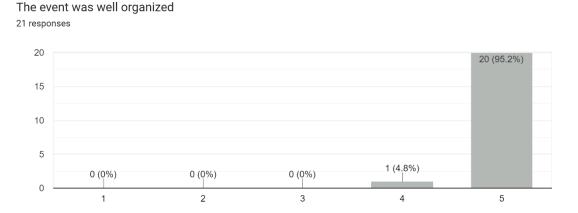
The event closed after offering them some open space to express the challenges that they face in Greece and what they believe should change, for more equal opportunities and a brighter future.

The next few days, we sent them via email all the links of what we explored together and the online evaluation form of the event, in order to collect the overall event's feedback. All of the participants submitted it and from the results we can say that the event was pretty successful with a high impact, the participants were really happy with their participation and they are looking forward to experiencing the e-learning platform .

Evaluation report:

Participants were asked to respond to a series of questions on a 5-point scale. The questions concerned the sufficiency of the multiplier event and the utility of the online platform. There was a total of 21 different responses.

The following findings were made:



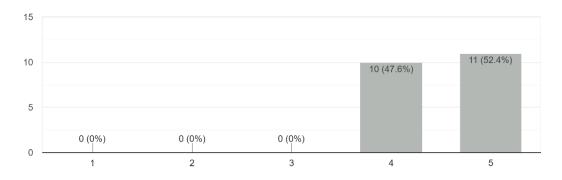
According to the survey results, the multiplier event was well organized, and the event content was well prepared and delivered. The event was well organized, according to all 20 participants.







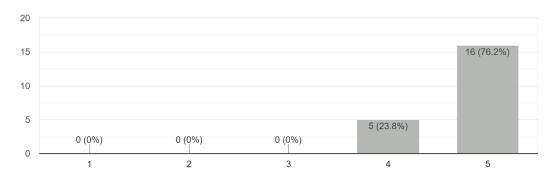
The contents of the event were well prepared and delivered 21 responses

21 responses



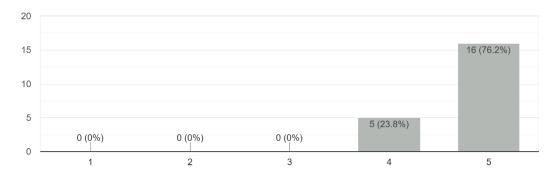




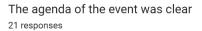


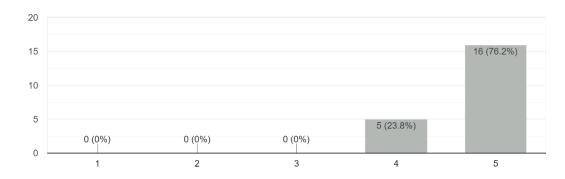
The objectives of the event were met

Stakeholders believe that the multiplier event had clear objectives that were met. More specifically, 16 participants agreed completely and 5 agreed with the preceding statement.





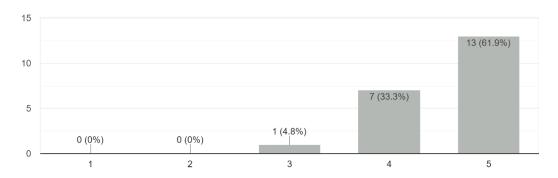
At the same time, 16 participants totally agreed and 5 participants agreed that the agenda of the multiplier event was clear.







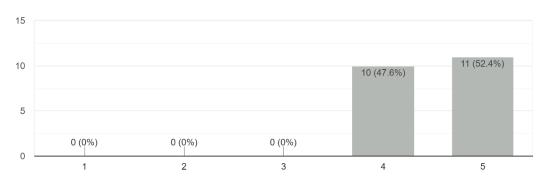
The event created sufficient opportunities for networking 21 responses

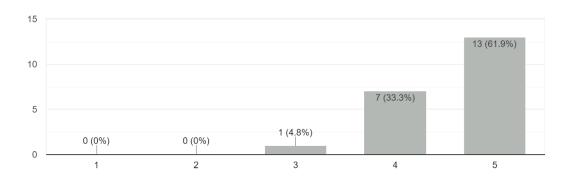
The online platform and online materials are easy to use and friendly, according to 11 of the 21 participants, while the rest agreed with the above statement.



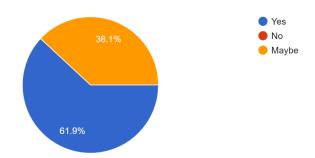




The event increased my awareness for the topic 21 responses

In general, the outcomes were overwhelmingly positive. The survey also revealed that the majority of participants completely agreed that the multiplier event increased the participants awareness of the topic, while the majority of stakeholders (61.9%) intend to use the online platform in the future.
