“Social and Economic Empowerment of Migrant Women” – WINGS

In Cyprus, the end of the WINGS project was celebrated through the organisation of the local WINGS multiplier event that took place on Saturday, 29th of October 2022, at the premises of University of Central Lancashire (UCLan) Cyprus Campus (Address: University Ave 12-14, Pyla 7080). This event intended to present the objectives and results of the WINGS project and introduce the personal stories of migrant women who participated in the WINGS Local Action Programme.

An invitation was sent to more than 140 individuals and organisations that have a strong interest on migrant inclusion strategies. A total number of 37 individuals participated in the event mostly students of Social Sciences and Humanities that wished to become familiar with the project results and outcomes.

The event started at 11:00 with a warm welcome from the project’s local implementation manager, Dora Heracleous. Then Dora proceeded by giving a presentation of the WINGS Project and it’s aims and objectives. She then introduced the basic concepts that were included in the WINGS Building Basic Skills Handbook that could be later used by the students in their own work enhancing thus the multiplier effect of the project deliverables.

Dora also introduced the WINGS Local Action Programme and the lessons learned showing the participants the most important findings from the transnational report. She then took the opportunity to show the eLearning platform and encouraged those present to log on the platform and avail themselves of the online resources online.

Finally, Dora introduced the WINGS good practice e-booklet in which testimonials, interviews, and photos from the experiences of migrant women from the WINGS Local Action Programme were detailed. The evening progressed by a very insightful Q & A session where participants had the opportunity to ask questions about the project.
