true inclusion and socio-economic empowerment of migrant women is possible and effective only if pursued with strong and structured strategies focused on these 5 fields.



Our recommendations

Cultural induction:

“Migrant women should become members of NGO's working towards their rights in order to give opportunity for locals and migrant women to be engaged in the same projects.”

Financial planning, job seeking and CV writing:

“Production and dissemination of user-friendly material, not only online but also on paper and in several languages, with the most useful basic information for functional money management.”

“Design and implementation of training programmes and workshops on CV writing, job search and interviewing, tailored to individual needs, with simplified and user-friendly content.”

Administrative support:

“Training of the administrative employees on how to help and support migrant population to navigate the administrative processes.”

“Design and implementation of a longer-term national inclusion strategy with a special focus on migrant women's one with the inclusion of the civil society, experts, and academics in the drafting process.”

Language learning:

“Organizing more speaking clubs and discussion sessions; adapting content of training courses according to the needs of migrant women; get local citizens to actively participate in community centres, to maximise the contact options between migrants and locals.”

Recognition of academic diplomas:

“An easier recognition and harmonisation of university degrees and qualifications, which would facilitate migrant women integration into the labour market and help them access their professional field.”
